Brothers and Sisters,

Effective January 1, 2026, TWU Local 555 will implement a new automated system to provide electronic notification to members that have any dues arrears (outstanding/unpaid dues) and to provide electronic invoices with online payment capability. This new system is designed to keep members informed of arrear amounts, to create a simple method for members to stay current, and to ensure compliance with Article Thirty-One of our CBA and the TWU Constitution. It is understood that, for a variety of reasons, some members have experienced situations where insufficient paycheck amounts have prevented full automatic deduction of dues. Over the years, these unpaid balances can accumulate into significant amounts.

All members are required to remain current on their union dues. Members who fall behind on dues payments, and that fail to make efforts to become current, may bear the responsibility of actions outlined in Article Thirty-One of our CBA and the TWU Constitution.

Please ensure that your current address and contact information are up to date in Workday. Failure to receive notices due to incorrect contact information will not exonerate members from paying dues. We strongly encourage all members to act on any notifications that they receive regarding union dues arrears. Addressing these issues as soon as possible will ensure that members are being treated in a consistent manner.
