## COVID-19 Update #8

Brothers and Sisters, in our continued effort to protect 555 members during this challenging period and after significant lobbying efforts, the Company has agreed to allow members to wear the N-95 or surgical masks during their shifts. However, as supplies of masks throughout the Country are extremely limited, the Company is unable to provide them.

The Union continues to meet with the Company regarding the inventory of necessary items to ensure a sanitary and safe working environment for all of you. To assist in this proactive effort, we have requested feedback from our local representatives throughout the system concerning the availability of hand sanitizer, latex gloves, Clorox wipes, cleaning supplies, and whether or not additional cleaning has been performed in break areas.
